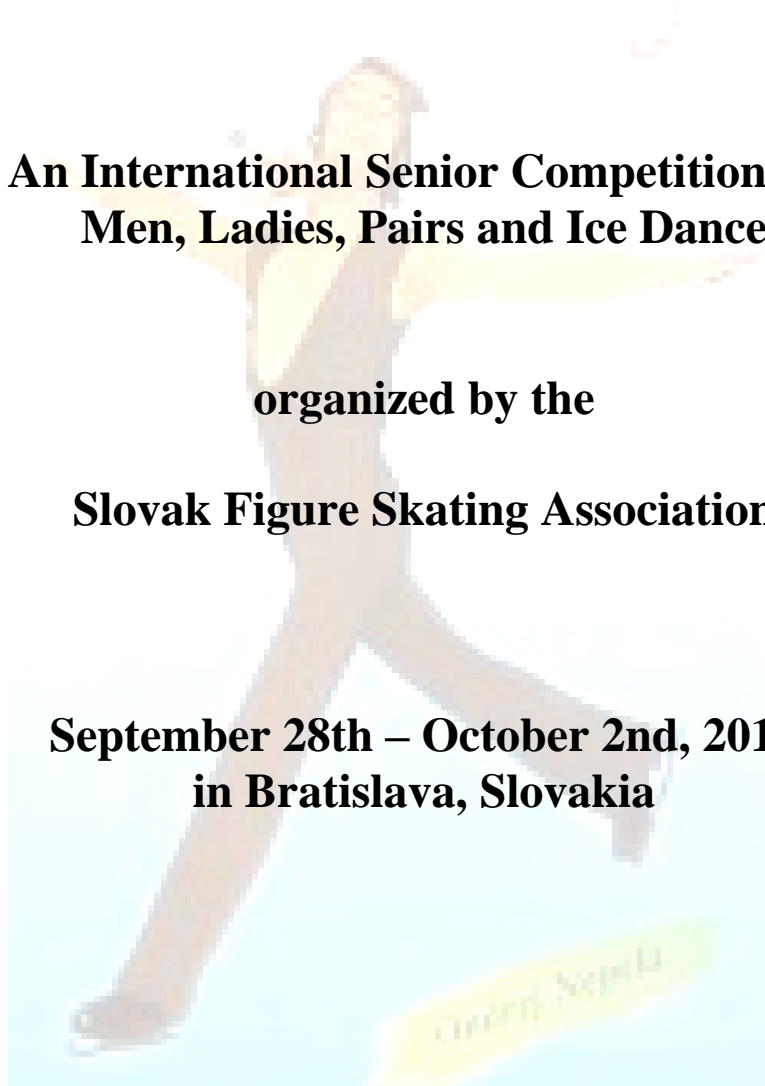
19th ONDREJ NEPELA MEMORIAL

**An International Senior Competition for
Men, Ladies, Pairs and Ice Dance**

organized by the

Slovak Figure Skating Association

**September 28th – October 2nd, 2011
in Bratislava, Slovakia**



The 19th Ondrej Nepela Memorial will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and the General Regulations 2010, the Special Regulations for Single and Pair Skating, the Special Regulations for Ice Dance 2010, the Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010 and the Technical Rules Ice Dance 2010 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the Ondrej Nepela Memorial is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2.b) and paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 1420.

Pasports of the skaters as well as the Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

The winners of the Single, Pairs and Ice Dance category will receive the medals and diplomas. All competitors will receive diplomas.

Region

Welcome to Bratislava. Ours is an old city, but one of Europe's newest capitals. As we hope you will see, it is big enough to have everything a visitor might want, but small enough to remain welcoming and unpretentious. Bratislava became a capital city when Slovakia became independent, in 1993. It has rapidly acquired the top-class hotels, restaurants and tourist facilities that reflect its status. But the town's history goes back centuries, to pre-Roman times. Successive waves of development as a major trading centre and, for almost 300 years, as the coronation city for the kings and queens of Hungary have blessed us with a fascinating blend of architecture and public spaces. The intimate old town, overlooked by the castle, is criss-crossed with narrow, traffic-free lanes and studded with mediaeval churches, Baroque palaces, small shops and fine cafes, bars and restaurants. At its centre is the beautiful Old Town Square. Nearby, the unique New Bridge, built in the 1970s with its distinctive 'UFO' tower, spans the Danube River. On the right bank is central Europe's oldest public park, Sad Janka Krala, and next to it one of Bratislava's several modern shopping centres, Aupark. The city has a strong artistic tradition, with regular concert and opera performances at the Slovak National Theatre, and several outstanding galleries. Beyond the centre, Bratislava's superb position on the banks of the Danube and below the forested slopes of the Small Carpathian hills means a walk in the woods or a bicycle ride along the river are never more than a few minutes away. Only slightly further afield are the wine towns of the Small Carpathians. But any restaurant in the city will offer a range of local products, the fruit of our region's centuries-old winemaking tradition.

Bratislava is a safe, reasonably-priced destination that more and more visitors are now discovering. We look forward to welcoming you too.

Venue

A fully air-conditioned and heated ice rink of the size of 60 m by 30m – the new Ondrej Nepelala Arena offers a comfortable auditorium with 10,000 seats and convenient social and sanitary facilities, including the equipment for the disabled who can easily enter the auditorium on wheel-chairs. Visitors can be served in 2 restaurant (WIFI cable) and 4 cafeterias. 15 skyboxes have . This complex have got 2 practice ice rinks hall B 28 x 58 and hall A 26 x 56m. This copmplew was opening 10th of April 2011. Temperature in center ice rink : air +15°C, ice –5°C.

Climate

The average outside temperature during the period concerned is +20° Celsius at day and +8° Celsius at night.

Hotel

City Hotel Bratislava is one of the largest hotels in Slovak capital. It disposes of 8 meeting rooms and 1 congress hall. Congress hall is designed for events up to 350 participants. The eight meeting rooms and lounges might be easily connected. Ultimate privacy is provided VIP Cigar Lounge – first class room up to 10 people with comfortable leather seating, round table and hi-tech equipment.

Metropolitan Grill restaurant offers a pleasant place to enjoy a wide range of local and international dishes based on modern European cuisine. The restaurant is suitable for organizing weddings, parties and other events thanks to its modern interior design.

Lobby bar becomes a frequent place for relaxing cup of coffee, informal appointments as well as short business meetings. The hotel's summer terrace is most favourite place for hot summer nights.

City Hotel Bratislava offers 275 rooms in 3 different room categories standard (economy), business and business executive. All the rooms have a private bathroom, 2 separate beds or one queen-size bed, satellite TV, radio clock and high-speed internet plug-in connection. Most of the rooms have balcony. Business rooms have additional amenities including air conditioning, minibar and. The business suites have a small kitchen which is very useful especially for long-term stays or family trips.

Spacious parking lot disposes of more than 100 parking places.

Along with high-quality accommodation and delicious cuisine City Hotel Bratislava offers sport activity. Mini football field, which is capable also for playing tennis is situated beside the hotel.

How to reach Bratislava

The capital of Slovakia is not difficult to reach. While making your travel arrangements, you can find the following recommendations useful.

By plane To Bratislava of Milan Rastislav Štefánik International Airport (OSR)

The Airport is "Airport Bratislava" which is about 10 minutes far from official hotel and Ice Rink.

By train The railway Station is "Bratislava Railway Station" or

By bus,, Bratislava Bus Station – Mlynske Nivy"

To Wien – Swechat Airport (and then by train)

Regular shuttle bus between Wien and Bratislava airport each hour.

By car Hotel City Bratislava, Seberiniho 9, Bratislava – Ružinov
Guarded parking lot 6EUR / 24h
