

IARS figure skating competition rules:

The international figure skating competition series - in recreational and adult categories - called IARS (International Adult and Recreational Series) takes place in 3 countries. The series altogether includes 5 similarly announced competitions in Bulgaria, Hungary and Slovakia where everyone can compete according to the same rules.

The 5-competition-series will end with the 10th Avas Cup be organized on the 27-29 March, 2015. The final, aggregated results will be announced in this competition. The total result consists of the three best results, if the competitor has taken part at least in two competitions organized by two different countries.

The 5 competitions of the series are as follows:

- The 9th Eastern Hungarian Cup (22-23 November, 2014), Miskolc, Hungary;
- The 14th ICE BLADE Cup (6-7 December, 2014), Sofia, Bulgaria;
- 6. Žilinská Pirueta, (24-25 January, 2015), Žilina, Slovakia;
- The 15th ICE BLADE Cup (March 2015), Sofia, Bulgaria;
- The 10th AVAS Cup (27-29 March, 2015), Miskolc, Hungary.

Common rules of the series:

1. A competitor shall take part at least 3 competition.
2. The entry fee (charge) is 40 Eur / person by bank transfer and 50 Euro/person in cash in competition series.
3. If the competitor takes part in more than one competition, by judging the three best scores shall be summed.
4. If there is only one competitor in a given category, the earned scores shall not be counted to the competition series.
5. If the competitor takes part in more than one category within the series, then those categories shall be prized, in which the skater have taken part at least two times.
6. At the end of the competition series, in every single category only the first three places shall be awarded. The awards ceremony shall be taken after the final competition.
7. According to the rules, the three best results (ISU total segments score) earned in competition series shall be summed by judging and this shall give the final result.
8. In case of a tie at any place, with same scores, the technical marks earned by the scorers shall be summed and it shall determine the final ranking. If the summed technical marks are also equalled, then the competitors shall be ranked by the same place.
9. The best groups (country) also shall be ranked by the first three places. (Total results earned by group in the competition series / number of members in groups)
10. Only those competitors can take part and can be prized in group competition who have already taken part in individual competition and have 3 results previously.
11. The total value of the prizes and cups shall be announced by the last competition organizer towards the other participants and on their arrival, they shall hand the costs that are proportionally distributed between the three present organizer teams.
12. In competition series, any competitor as a member of the clubs from a given country can take part and also can be awarded. In addition to this, the group results of the clubs (country) shall include their individual results.
13. The sport club which organized a competition in series are entitled to receive a team cup.
14. At the final competition, the Committee shall be formed to evaluate the competitors.
15. The president for the above-mentioned Committee shall be the president of the sport club organizing the final competition.
16. The members of the above-mentioned Committee shall be delegated by the organizer club and shall possess the personal data of all competitors who take part in competition series.
