1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Tirnavia Ice Cup** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Tirnavia Ice Cup is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a and band they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, althoughhaving such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

Safety measures will be announced in weeks before the competition in accordance to the local regulations.

ADVANCED NOVICES Short Program

BOYS

In accordance with ISU Communication Single/Pair Skating for Novices – Comm. 2562.

(born after July 1st 2008 – June 30th 2011)

a) Single Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen

b) Double or triple jump, may not repeat jump a)

- c) One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump a) or b)
- d) Camel spin with or without change of foot and no flying entrance (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot if change of foot, minimum of six (6) revolutions without change of foot) (for season 2023/24).
- e) Spin combination with only one change of foot (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot). Flying entry is allowed.
- f) One step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Duration 2 min., 20 sec. +/-10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICES Short Program GIRLS

(born after July 1st 2008 – June 30th 2011)

The Short Program for Girls' Single Skating shall consist of the following elements:

- a) Single Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen
- b) Double or triple jump, may not repeat jump a)
- c) One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump a) or b)
- d) Layback/sideways leaning spin or camel spin in one basic position with no change of foot (minimum six (6) revolutions) and no flying entrance (for season 2023/24).
- e) Spin combination with only one change of foot (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot). Flying entry is allowed.
- f) One step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Duration 2 min., 20 sec. +/-10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICES Free Skating BOYS AND GIRLS

A well balanced Free Skating program for Single Boys and Girls must contain:

a) Maximum of 6 jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. One jump combination or jump sequence can consist of up to three (3) jumps, the other up to two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of two or three jumps of any number of revolutions, in which the second and/or the third jump is an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first/second jump into the take-off curve of the Axel jump. One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element

in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence 5 receive their full value. Only two triple jumps can be repeated either in a jump combination or jump sequence. No quadruple jumps are allowed. Any single, double (including Double Axel) or triple jump cannot be executed more than twice in total.

- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation). One spin must be a spin combination with a change of foot which must have a minimum of eight (8) revolutions, a flying entrance is not allowed. One spin must be a flying spin which must have a minimum of six (6) revolutions, a change of foot is allowed but a change of position is not allowed.
- c) There must be one Choreographic Sequence consisting of at least two different movements.

Duration: 3 min., +/- 10 sec.

3. ENTRIES

All entries for the 15th Tirnavia Ice Cup, must be done through the Google formular by the deadline indicated

List of entries (competitors, judges, technical panel, team leaders, other persons) must reach the organizer by **October 13th**, **2023.**

It is mandatory that the form "Planned Program Content Sheet" must be filled in for each skater of each category in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

Travel expenses will be paid only to the Referees, the Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers and Data/Replay Operators based on economy airfare. All Competitors, Coaches and Team Leaders have to bear their own expenses. All participants, except Referees and Judges on duty as well as the members of the Technical Panels on duty, have to pay for their own accommodation.

7. DRAW

The Starting orders will be drawn by the representative of Technical Controller/Referee for the short program. Starting orders for the second segment FS will be reverse order of the result of SP.

8. MUSIC

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on USB key in any other approved format. A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single and Pairs and attached to the official Entry Form for Competitors. In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2, all covers/discs must show the Competition event, Competitor's name, the Nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration.

All music must be provided to the Organizing Committee in MP3 format latest by **October 24th 2023** by sending to: **tirnaviaicecup2018@gmail.com**.

9. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS/TEAMS

The office of the organizing committee and the registration office will be located at the ice rink and will be opened every day during the competition.
