

## Important Update: ISU Anti-Doping Program now managed by ITA

Dear ISU Members,

As of July 1, 2025, the International Skating Union (ISU) has entered into a **new partnership** with the **International Testing Agency (ITA)** to further reinforce the protection of clean sport and strengthen independent expertise across all disciplines and competitions (read announcement [here](#)).

With this new agreement in place, the ITA now has **responsibility for overseeing the entire ISU Anti-Doping Program**. This includes among others **in-competition** and **out-of-competition testing** throughout the season, as well as **whereabouts, TUEs and ADAMS management**.
